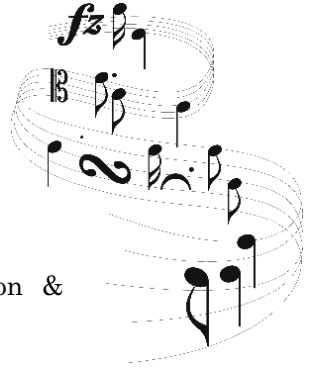
The band is always rehearsing new music to add to our repertoire, so you will always hear something new.

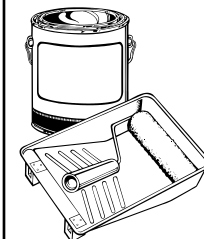
