April is our next scheduled event. The band travels West to Charlton to perform for the Masonic Home and the residence at Overlook on Saturday afternoon April 12th.

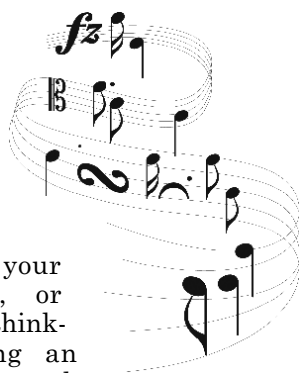
This is always a great event and an opportunity for the Masonic and Shrine residence

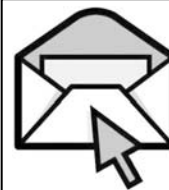
