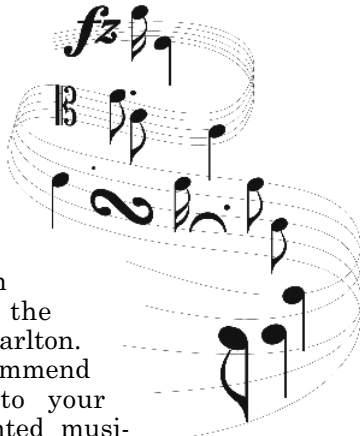
The Swing Band has been asked by Colonel **Charles Rivers** to play for the Heads of Units
