Don't forget the E. Ray Kelley Memorial Golf Tournament up in Cape Ann on August 28, 2010.

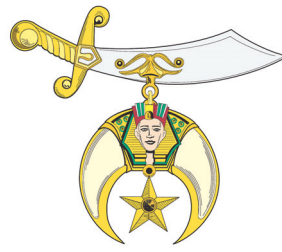

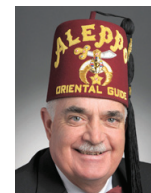

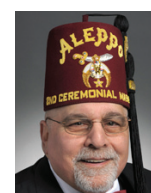
