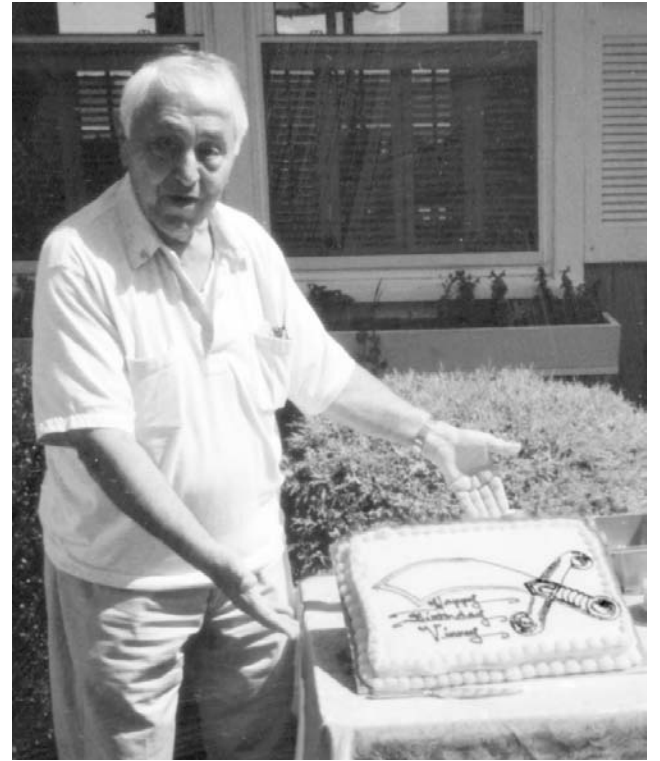
It was also announced that prior to next month's meeting, a field trip for the members was scheduled to tour the new Stop & Shop warehouse in Freetown.
